The Fast Break

At a Glance: Today, Reno looks to win its fourth-straight game after going 2-0 at the D-League Showcase and knocking off Texas last night...Reno has won its last three games by an average margin of 15.3 ppg...after this afternoon's contest, the 'Horns hit the road for a four-game, eight-day, three-city road trip (Tulsa, Iowa, Austin).

All-Time Series: Today's epic battle marks the second-ever meeting between the Bighorns and **Donnie Nelson's Texas Legends**...this season marks the first for the Legends...the franchise previously was called the Colorado 14ers, and was located in Broomfield, Colorado...the 14ers won the 2009 D-League championship in their final season as a team...Reno and Colorado split their only two meetings (in 2008-09 season).

This Land-Ry Is Our Land-ry: Bighorns **F Marcus Landry** drained four three-pointers last night on his way to a team-high 24 points...has now hit 3+ three-pointers in three-straight games (12-26, 46.2% during streak)...after shooting 36.8% from long range over first two months, has shot 48.1% during eight games in January (26-54)...sitting 13th in the league in 3PT FG% (41.5%)...is 2nd in the league with 54 made three-pointers (3rd in 3PT FGA, 130).

Give That Man a Patrick on the Back: Bighorns **F Patrick Ewing, Jr.** recorded his 7th double-double of the season last night (16 points, 12 rebounds)...is 10th in the league in double-doubles...also has one of four triple-doubles in the league this season (12/10 vs. RGV; 26 points, 10 rebounds, 11 assists)...has grabbed 12+ rebounds in three of his last five games (10.5 rpg during stretch)...has recorded 7+ rebounds in 14 games this season...is 6th in the league with 189 total boards and 11th in rebounds per game (8.6).

Hang On To the Rock: Last night, Reno forced 22 Texas turnovers and committed just 11...the 'Horns are 3rd in the league in turnover differential (+2.9 per game)...Reno is 12-1 when committing fewer turnovers than their opponent...are just 2-7 when losing the turnover battle...the Bighorns are averaging just 14.0 turnovers per game during three-game winning streak (forcing 20.7 during streak).

If It Ain't Broke...: Reno has used the same starting lineup in three-straight games for the first time since games #6-10 (12/3-12/15)...the current incarnation (**Sloan, Lin, Landry, Ewing, Richardson**) is the eighth lineup that the Bighorns have used, and is undefeated so far (3-0)...is one of two Bighorns starting fives to have a perfect record (also **Miles, Charlo, Landry, Ewing, Fazekas**: 6-0)...11 different Bighorns players have cracked the starting lineup at least once this season...**F Patrick Ewing, Jr.** is the only player to have started every game this season.

Biggest Little Notes in the World: The 'Horns shot 95 field goals last night, their most in a single game this season...Reno outscored Texas 60-36 in the paint yesterday...last night's attendance of 3,637 was the highest since opening night (4,191)...**G Jeremy Lin** had four steals last night for the second-straight game...Reno is 6-1 in 1st of 2-straight games against the same opponent (2-4 in 2nd-consecutive game against same opponent).

RENO, Nev.—Reno turned 22 Texas turnovers into 30 points Saturday night, as the Bighorns knocked-off the Legends, 108-95, in the first of a weekend series in the Reno Events Center.

Over a five-minute stretch in the second period, Reno went on a 20-2 run and went to intermission with a 21-point advantage over the Legends. Texas returned the favor early in the third quarter, though, fashioning a 22-3 spurt of its own and eventually cutting Reno's lead to just three.

From that point forward, though, the Bighorns took control, picking up their third-straight victory.

Marcus Landry knocked down three three-pointers on his way to 24 points for the Bighorns. Patrick Ewing, Jr. scored 16 and pulled down 12 boards, and Donald Sloan notched 18 points. Jeremy Lin, on assignment from the Golden State Warriors, collected 21 points, seven boards and six assists in 38 minutes of action.

Joe Alexander led the way for Texas with 24 points and 11 rebounds, marking his eighth-straight double-double. Sean Williams blocked seven shots for the Legends.
